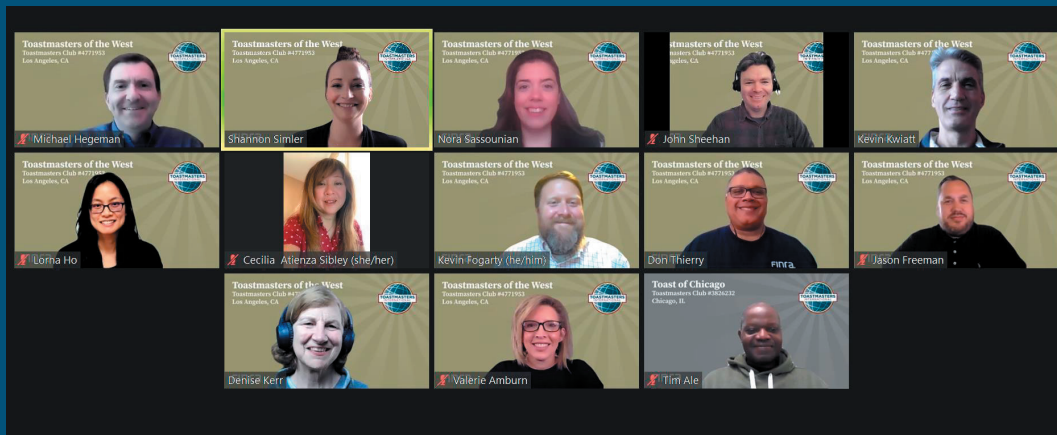
Fun Facts

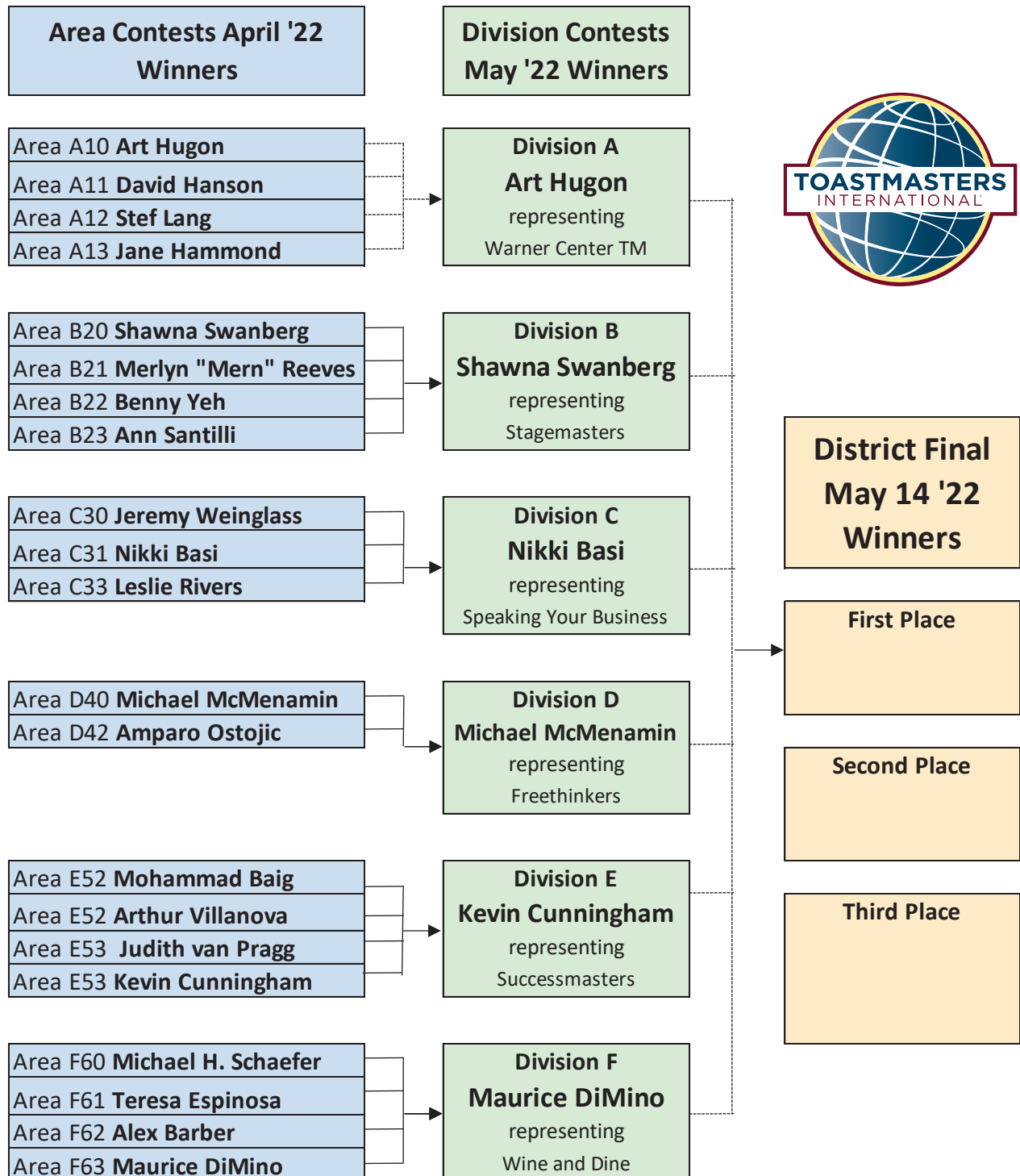

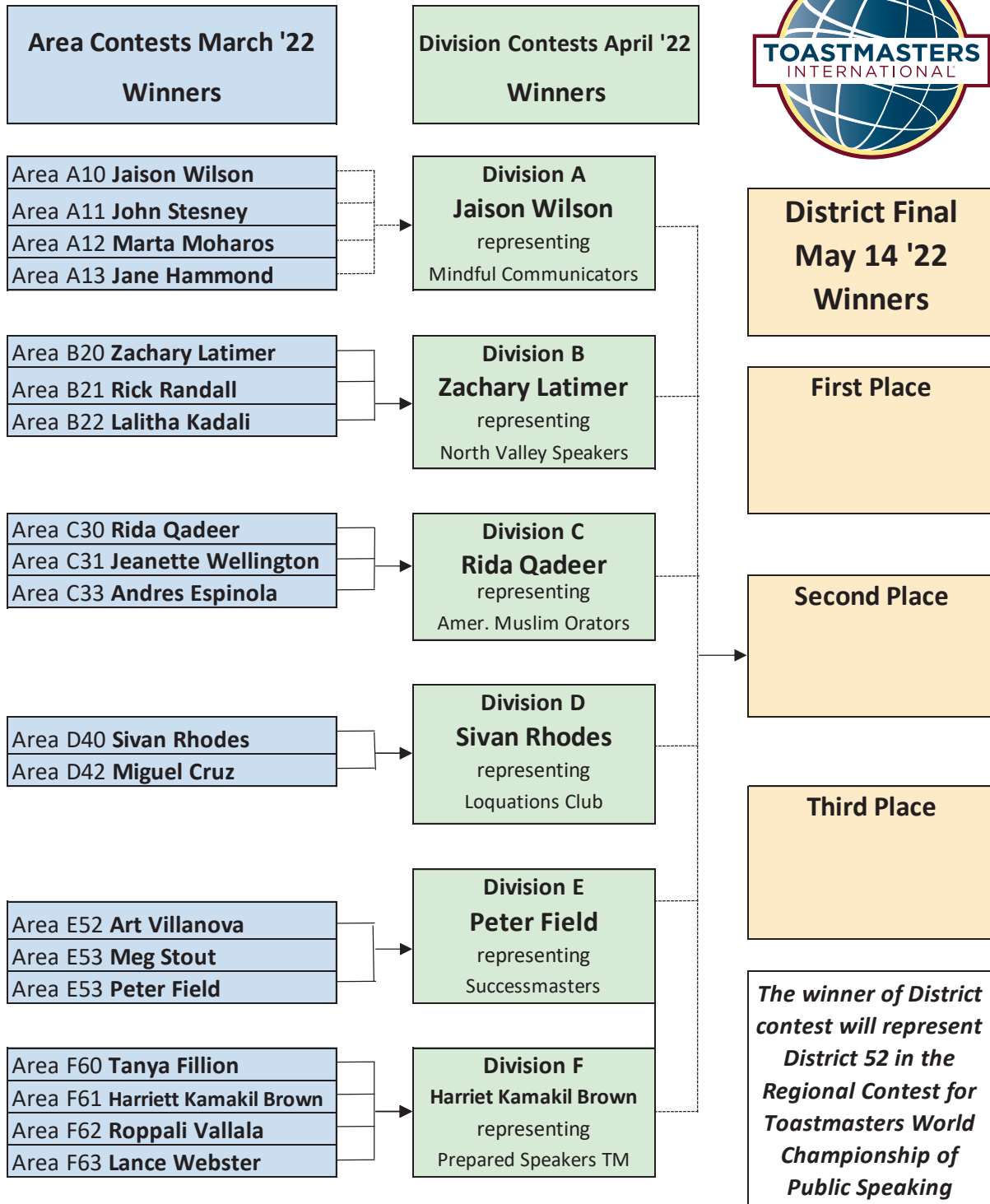
