Problem

- Some clubs have difficulty attracting members.
- Clubs often hold events such as an open-house which are not well advertised outside the club.
- New specialty clubs may not be known to Toastmasters who are not directly involved in the club formation and therefore may not be aware of a club they would be interested in joining.

Proposal

Meetup.com is commonly used by business networking groups to connect with business people or those with a niche interest. People go to meetup.com and actively search for local groups or existing members receive automatic notices about groups which match interests they select. Meetup.com can be used to promote Toastmasters to new members and to keep existing members connected even during times when they are unable to attend meetings.

Creating & Maintaining

- > Create a header or banner for the top of the Meetup page (It should look similar to your website)
- > Think of around three questions to add that visitors/potential members could answer
- Respond to visitors
- Add photos from meetings
- > Have visitors that join add a photo of themselves, so that you can get an idea of who they are
